## **Completed actions**

# **Current status on US GODAE SERVER situation**

(brief summary from this meeting)

- Meeting with NOAA took place and Emily Smith is interested in taking the initiative forward
- Server requirements need to be discussed/agreed
  - Class 4 data storage capacity (could be less than 1 TB if a rolling data update, e.g. quarterly, would be implemented
  - Service support (it was suggested that a 5-day support regime would be sufficient, no 24/7 support required)
  - User interface for the server would be helpful
  - Consideration of preservation of historic in-situ data
- Plan to mirror the server at MOi
- Recent issues with depositing data on US server related to access /authentication needs attention
- IV-TT to work with OS-Eval/SynObs on use of server and data needs. Request for SynObs data to be hosted on server
- Possibility for (Eric C) to provide alternative server/data capacity at FSU
- DCC maybe able to support this effort to be explored
- Endorsement from IOC/WMO?



# **OPAS meeting outcomes (30 Jan 2023)**

- Governance/ToR doc approved: main updates are the inclusion of OP partners/ relationships descriptions and forming of a new executive committee within OP comprising the OPST co-chairs, PO rep and one co-chair from each TTs (supports vision and mission discussions for OceanPredict, should work closely with the OPAS on OP direction, should foster collaboration with other institutes, e.g. with the DCC and UN Decade programmes)
- Funding situation discussed: Need for increasing OP funding was highlighted; consideration
  of using funded projects to fill gaps
- Need for increasing OP visibility and branding highlighted: improvement of communication to be addressed; suggestion of better showcasing OP, including showing societal and economic benefits and added value of OP, addressing the right audience
- OP '24 endorsed by OPAS: see previous presentation; suggestion to consider running an external review at the same time

  - Agreement with OPAS to open a new OP office at MOi

  - OPAs meeting in Jan 2023

- Coming up

- OPST-6 Action 5: OP, ForeSea and CoastPredict chairs to work together to develop description of the OP, ForeSea and CoastPredict roles (e.g. to allow better definition of associated project like PredictOnTime) to better define OP and UN Decade programmes for wider understanding, including group strategies (lead: OP, CoastPredict and ForeSea chairs)
